ACARA's policy position

ACARA's policy position is that excessive preparation for NAPLAN is not useful, can lead to unnecessary anxiety and is not a good use of valuable teaching and learning time for students. Visit the ['NAPLAN questions and answers' page](#) of the NAP website for more information.

As such, ACARA does not want to contribute to this issue by enabling past NAPLAN tests to be made available, especially on a commercial basis or otherwise, to drill students in preparation for future NAPLAN tests. Instead, ACARA has published a [full set of example tests](#) that teachers can use to familiarise students with the format of tests.

NAPLAN tests – copyright

All of the NAPLAN tests provided to you have been released under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982 (FOI Act)*. The FOI Act gives you access to documents. It does **not** give you any copyright rights in relation to the documents that have been released (see section 91 of the FOI Act).

In relation to all NAPLAN tests provided to you by ACARA, please be aware:

- ACARA owns all the NAPLAN test questions and some of the images. ACARA reserves all its rights in relation to this material and does not give you any rights in relation to it.
- Some images (photographs and illustrations) and some text included in the NAPLAN tests provided to you by ACARA are owned by third parties and licensed to ACARA. You do **not** have any rights in relation to this material.

This means that, unless a defence or other exception to copyright infringement applies, you can only use the NAPLAN tests provided to you by ACARA for your own personal use (such as for research or study) provided that the use is also 'fair'.
